General Remarks:

1. The presentations will last 25 to 40min, followed by a discussion of 45min or so, in which more clarification about the presented topic can be sought and where everybody is invited to comment about relations between his/her own field of interest and the presented topic. In this way we hope to have a lively dialogue and a rich exchange of ideas.
2. The presentations and discussions will be taped and some possibly also filmed. The team of translators will use the documents of the contributors and the taping for working out the translations as soon as possible. If the speakers bring along their manuscripts, if possible in electronic format, this would be very helpful.
3. The preparatory text documents available as downloads on <http://www.educare.ch> will be discussed on announced times throughout our dialogue.
4. There will be a number of films and talks on video available (see „List of Materials“). Depending on the interest, viewings will be arranged at suitable late afternoon or evening times.
5. The DLIHE will be informed about our schedule and side activities so that possibly students and teachers of this institution will sometimes be present.
6. It is one of the aims of the dialogue to produce a publication which can serve further similar dialogue projects. Alexis Dworsky will observe and comment about our dialogue. He is the representative of our sponsor, the Andrea von Braun Foundation in Germany (<http://www.avbstiftung.de/>).
7. Of course we must be open to ad hoc changes during the workshop according to special needs and common wishes.
